When completing the nomination form, we ask that you answer the questions as complete as possible.

About the organization and initiative

Please note: the form contains questions relating both to your organization and to the initiative (project) you are submitting. If your initiative encompasses the organization, please answer the questions accordingly.

- Since when has your organization been active?
- What is the organization's legal form?
- What is the name of the initiative you are nominating?
- Since when has the initiative been active?
- In which location (town/city, province, island) is the initiative you are nominating carried out?
- Is the initiative also implemented in other locations? If so, please specify where.
- How many people are involved in the initiative on a voluntary basis?
- How many paid staff members are involved in the initiative?

The initiative

- What was the reason for starting your initiative?
- Why do you believe your organization should win an Appeltje van Oranje? What makes your initiative urgent, distinctive, or innovative?
- What do you aim to achieve with this initiative, and why is this important?
- What activities do you organize to prevent or reduce poverty, or to empower people experiencing (or at risk of) poverty? Please provide a brief description of your activities and indicate how frequently they take place.
- Which groups or organizations do you collaborate with as part of the initiative, and in what way?
- How do your activities contribute to reducing, preventing, or alleviating (the consequences of) poverty and/or debt? How do you know that this approach is effective?

Target group

- Which target groups does your initiative primarily focus on?
- Why is this the right approach for the target group you aim to reach? How many people participate? How do the activities contribute to strengthening and connecting the target group?
- How do you reach people experiencing (or at risk of) poverty and/or debt?
- How do you involve volunteers and/or experts by experience in the initiative? What role do they play?

- How does the target group itself play a role in the design and implementation of the project?
- How does your initiative contribute to a positive public perception of the target group?

Funding and attachments

- How is your organization funded?

Please include the following attachments:

- Your organization's articles of association.
- A recent extract of your organization's Chamber of Commerce registration.
- Last year's financial statements (including balance sheets and/or information on your organization's savings).
- Three photos of the organization (preferably high-resolution JPG or PNG format)
- The latest substantive annual report or an overview of your organization's activities in the previous year.
